The employees of the library can assist you in finding this information. For the young there is Kid Zone and Teen Scene with many topics of interest listed under each.

You can get a list of services that can be provided or research, like genealogy volunteers can help you with.

There are E Sources or electronic books that can be downloaded, Catalogs, book news, Santa Rosa County information and general information. You also have the opportunity to be involved in online or in library clubs.
